Dear parent, Assalamu Alaikum (may peace be upon you),

I hope this letter finds you in good health and Imaan.

We would like to thank all our parents for their support in the home learning for the first week. As we are halfway through our second week of home learning, we would like to thank our parents for their efforts in ensuring their son is participating in learning, whether that is through their work packs, or through digital learning on Microsoft Teams and One Note – using the pack A folder to support the learning. Please note, that your son should be completing Work Pack A by Friday 03 April.

Work Pack B was created this week by staff and thank you to those parents who have collected their son's files from school today. For those who have not collected them, please ensure they are collected from school between 10am-1pm tomorrow (Wednesday), as they will complement your son's learning from Monday 20 April, for 5 weeks (Summer term 1). For those families who are currently self-isolating, please collect Work Pack B from school on Wednesday 15 April, between 10am-1pm. This is allowing for the 14 days isolation period required if there is a family member who is displaying the symptoms. The school is unable to drop off files to your home. Please note, there is no learning scheduled in the Easter holidays.

We are also looking at the possibility of possibly introducing digital learning for Year 7 and Year 8 pupils if possible. An electronic form will shortly follow for Year 7 and Year 8 parents which we are kindly asking parents to complete.

As Ramadhan is fast approaching, we would like to inform you that a Ramadhan digital timetable is being created and will be shared with parents in Year 9 and Year 10 shortly before Ramadhan. It will have a similar weighting of the current digital lessons. However, the timings will vary, allowing the pupils to have a later start than the current 9 a.m.
