Dear parent / guardian

Assalaamu 'Alaikum (Peace be with you)

I pray that you are having a spiritually fulfilling Ramadhan.

I want to pay tribute to all parents and carers for your amazing efforts and selflessness during this extraordinary period – in particular, I am very grateful for your support with the delivery of home learning to your children, our pupils and your wonderful contributions to the STAR Family Appeal. I am delighted yet humbled to share with you that Tahueedul Boys are delivering hundreds of food boxes and hot meals alongside hygiene packs to targeted families and care settings in our school community. I am extremely proud of the collective efforts of every member of the Tahueedul Boys family at this unprecedented time.

No doubt you would be aware of the Prime Ministers announcement on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020 regarding schools. The Government has advised that educational establishments may be in a position to begin the reopening of schools from the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

For secondary schools, the Government's aspiration is that pupils with exams next year – Y10 will get face-to-face contact with their teachers during the final half term. Secondary pupils in all other year groups are expected to continue to learn at home until the end of the summer term.

I am aware Y7 have been working from work packs provided by the school since 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 and we realise that in light of the Governments advice there is a strong possibility that Y7 may not come back to school this academic year. Therefore, I am looking to create a digital timetable to compliment work pack C, which will be available to collect week commencing 18<sup>th</sup> May. Any digital timetable will begin from 01<sup>st</sup> June 2020 – after the May half term holidays.

In order for us to speed up implementing the digital timetable into Y7, I would appreciate the following [online form](#) be filled out so that the school has a better understanding of how many pupils will be in a position to access the digital timetable when it is launched.

I would like to reinforce that the school has no ICT kit available to be loaned out to parents as all of our equipment has been given to our pupils who will be sitting GCSEs next year. Therefore, if parents do not have a device and cannot purchase one, they should continue to use the work pack to support learning. There will be a timetable available to offer structured learning, this can be located in the work pack.

The resources are produced to a high standard by qualified teachers in all subjects. At Tauheedul Boys we have some of our Maths teachers who are preparing resources for our Y9 Maths curriculum.
