# Elite University Preparation Programme

**In the first term of Year 12 the senior admissions officer from Harvard University will visit TB6 to give an overview of studying abroad.**

From here, students who want to explore studying abroad further have opportunities to attend additional workshops and seminars run throughout the year which cover topics such as completing the Common Application, writing an effective personal statement, Financial Aid and how to make yourself stand out. Towards the end of Y12, interested students will begin their SAT preparation.

Additionally in October of the first term, a group of Year 12 students will have the opportunity to attend an exploration trip in Boston and New York. The visit will allow them to find out more about MIT, Harvard, Princeton, Yale and Columbia' to hear from admissions tutors about the liberal arts programme, visit the campus, meet undergraduate students and participate in excursions to visit the key sites in Boston, New York, New Jersey and New Haven, including but not limited to Statue of Liberty and Times Square.

Students will be offered rigorous support with Oxford and Cambridge preparation and benefit from links with Russell Group universities.

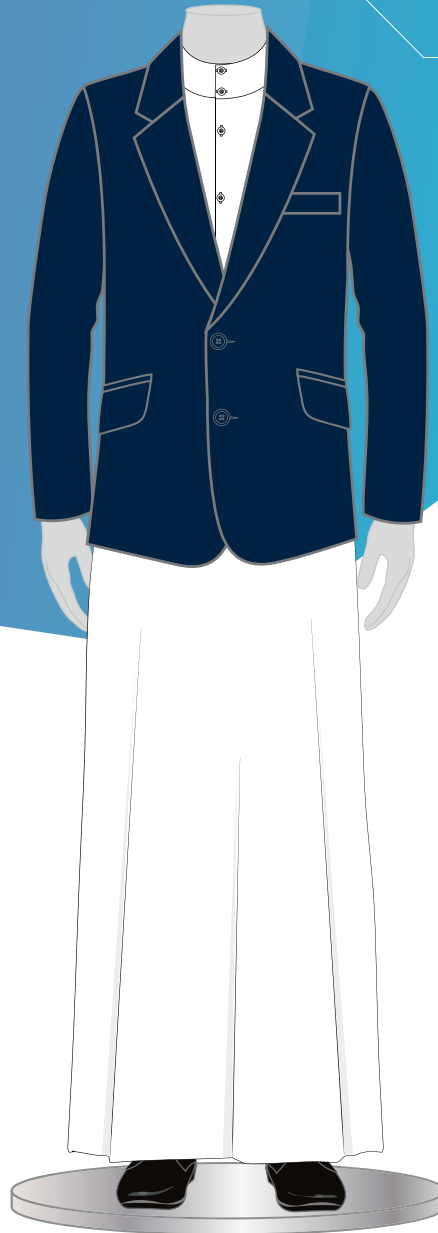
# And Next Steps

- Monday 5th September - First full teaching day for Y12 at TB6 from 7.50am till 3.05pm.

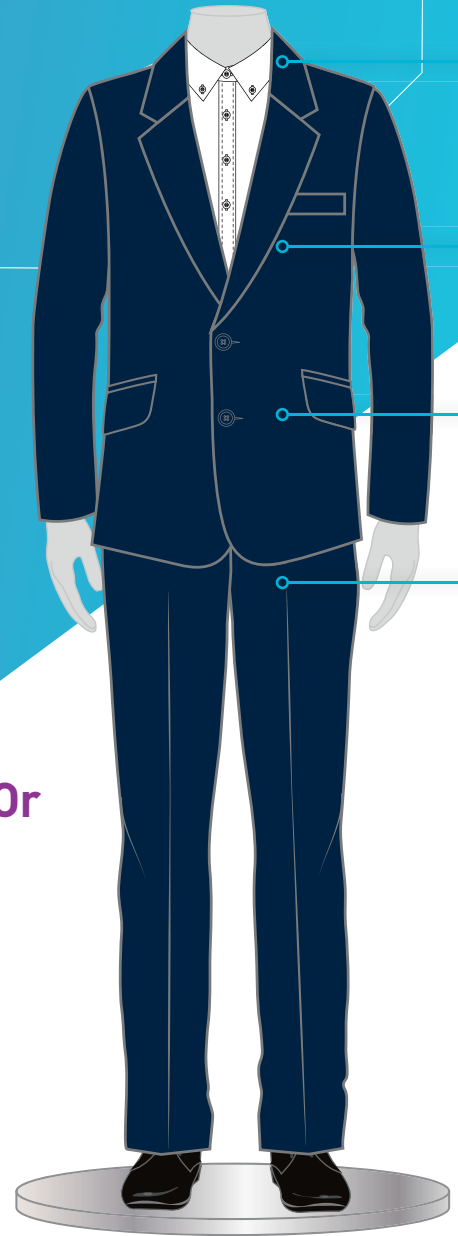
# Uniform

### Collar

### Waist

Measure around the waist at the natural waistline (the smallest part)

### Trouser Length

Measure with shoes on from the crotch to where the trouser is normally worn.

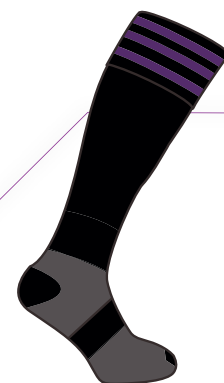
